

Card Base	Number of Pieces	Metric	Imperial
Card Base - Pool Party /Night Of Navy	1	10.5cmx 27.9cm scored@14.9cm	4 ¼" x 11" scored@5 ½"
Layer 1: Pool Party /Night Of Navy	1	9.7cm x 14.1cm	4" X 5 ¼"
Layer 2: Basic Beigi (embossed)	1	5cm x 14.1cm	2" x 5 ¼"
Basic White or Very Vanilla -Inside	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4" x 5 ¼"
Scrap pieces of Shaded Spruce, Pecan pie, Garden Green and Basic Black for die-cutting and sentiment

- The Base Card Pool Party, followed by another layer of Pool Party. Emboss the cardstock using the Brich 3D embossing folder on Night Of Navy and Basic Beigi cardstock, then sponge the colour Night of Naivay and then distress the edges of the cardstock using Papersnips scissors to get the rough edge.
- Splatter some Shaded Spruce Ink to the background of the card.
- Adhere Layer 2 to Layer 1 and then attach it to the base card using glue.
- Stamp the image on Basic White cardstock using the Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad and colour the images using the Stampin' Blends -Shaded Spruce combo pack, Light Real Red and Dark Cherry Cobbler blends.
- Die-cut some of the leaves from the cardstocks- Pecan Pie, Shaded Spruce, Early Espresso and stamped the sentiment on Basic Black.
- Fussy-cut the image from the bird image from the Designer Series Paper and attach it to the centre of the card using glue and Stampin' Dimensional.
- Don't forget to decorate the inside of the card.
